\*Northern Rhodesia was a protectorate in south central Africa, formed in 1911 by amalgamating the two earlier protectorates of North-Western Rhodesia and North-Eastern Rhodesia. It was initially administered, as were the two earlier protectorates, by the British South Africa Company, (BSAC), a chartered company on behalf of the British government. From 1924 it was administered by the British government as a protectorate under similar conditions to other British-administered protectorates, and the special provisions required when it was administered by BSAC were terminated. Although under the BSAC charter it had features of a charter colony, the BSAC's treaties with local rulers and British legislation gave it the status of a protectorate. The Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland formed in 1953 was intensely unpopular among the African majority and its formation hastened

83. As the temperature of ice rises, the ice melts and its density\*:

\* The most obvious property that changes is its state. When ice melts, water changes from a solid to a liquid. Other properties that change are its temperature and its total energy. For example, if ice has an initial temperature of -2 degrees Celsius and is heated, it will absorb heat energy. Its temperature will rise and its total energy will increase until it reaches 0 degrees C. Once the temperature of the ice reaches 0 degrees C, the ice continues to absorb heat and its total energy increases. All of the heat at this temperature goes into the change of state from solid to liquid, so the temperature remains at 0 degrees C. Once the ice has absorbed enough heat energy to melt, it forms liquid water at 0 degrees C. If the heating continues, the temperature of the resulting water rises once more, and the total energy of the water continues to increase. Another property that changes is its density. The density of ice is less than that of liquid water. However, when ice melts, the density of the resulting water is about 8% more dense than the original ice. But that's not all. As the temperature of the water increases from 0 degrees C, its density continues to increase. This behavior is contrary to that of nearly every other liquid. Then, at 4 degrees C, water reaches its maximum density. As the temperature increases above 4 degrees C, the density decreases. In practically all other substances, the solid form is more dense than the liquid form. For water, this difference has profound consequences, the most significant being that ice floats in cold water. When a pond or lake freezes in winter,
