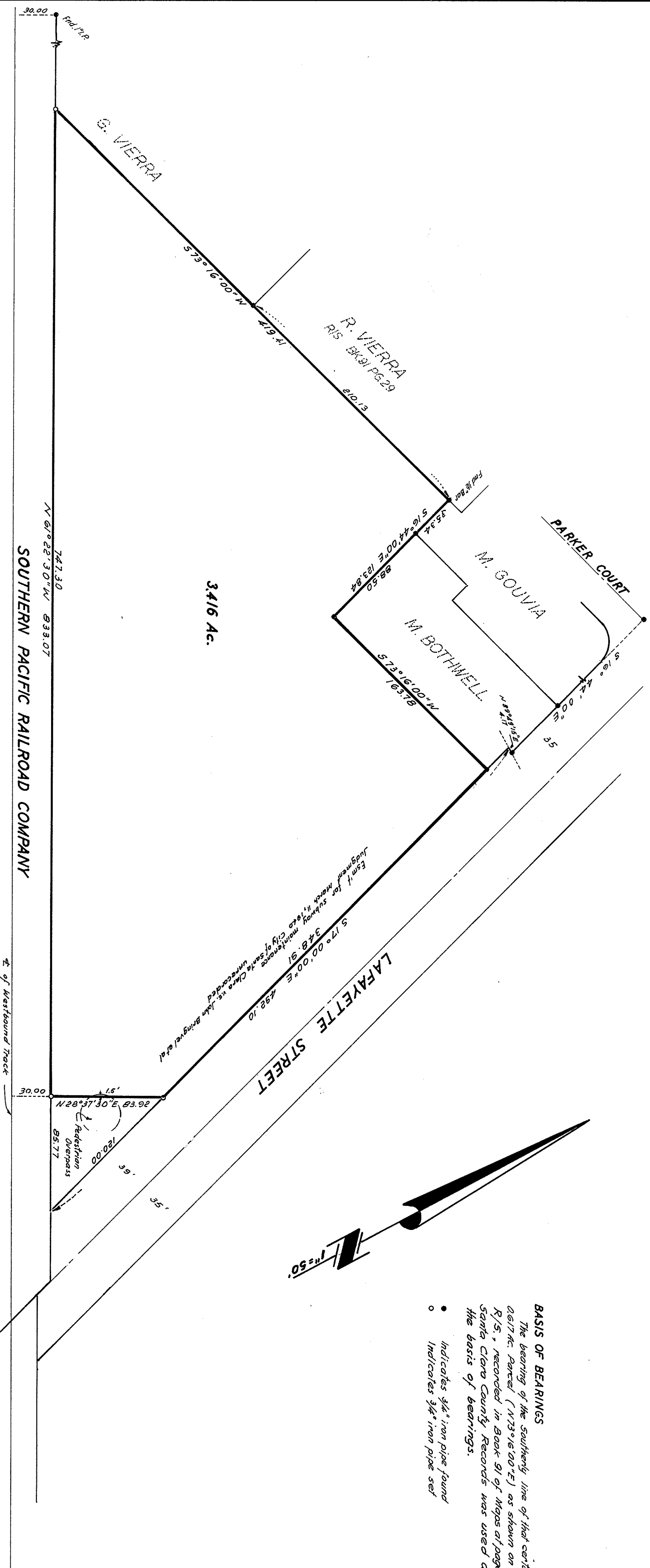
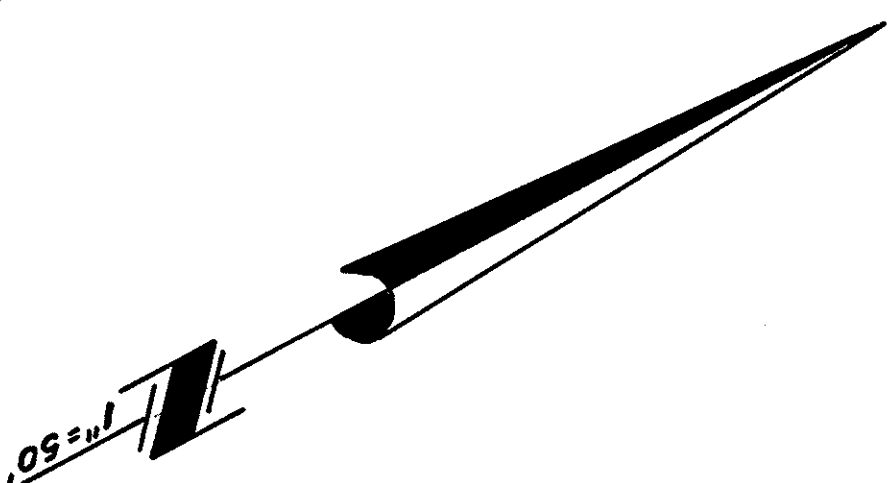


BASIS OF BEARINGS
